

**ITINERARY - M/V CANADIAN EMPRESS**  
**SEAWAY DISCOVERY CRUISE**  
**KINGSTON TO MONTREAL TO KINGSTON (7 nights - 8 days)**

- DAY 1 1715 - Pre-boarding commences on Crawford Dock in **Kingston, Ontario**  
1730-1830 - Passenger boarding  
1800 - Captain's Welcome Reception in the Grand Saloon  
1900 - Depart Kingston bound for **1000 Islands Anchorage**  
Dinner - Empress Class Roast Prime Rib of Beef  
After Dinner - Enjoy the beauty of the 1000 Islands on the upper deck with complimentary chocolate and liqueurs  
Evening - Stroll the outer decks under a million stars and among a thousand islands
- DAY 2 0800 - Weigh anchor to wander the 1000 Islands, Wanderer's Channel and Admiralty Group of Islands bound for Gananoque  
0915 - Arrive at **Gananoque, Ontario**  
0930 - Debark at Gananoque for a guided tour of the *1000 Islands Heritage Museum*  
1100 - Depart Gananoque bound for Brockville, Ontario  
Lunch - Comprehensive Safety Presentation  
Afternoon - See Millionaires' Row on the U.S side. Sight Boldt and Singer Castles.  
1515 - Arrive at **Brockville, Ontario**

- Cruise past Windmill Point and along the Old Galop Canal - opened 1846  
Evening - Arrive at **Crysler Park Marina**

Evening - Evening Entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 3 0915 - Depart by horse-drawn wagon to *Upper Canada Village*. After an open-air guided tour, passengers will have free time to discover the Village  
1200 - Transportation returns from Village  
1230 - Depart Crysler Park Marina bound for Coteau Landing, Quebec  
Afternoon - Transit Eisenhower & Snell Locks (USA)  
Evening - Ship arrives at **Coteau Landing, Quebec**  
- Free time to relax and stroll along the old canal system  
Evening - Fun-loving entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 4 0700 - Depart Coteau Landing bound for Lachine (near Montreal)  
Morning - Pass through Beauharnois Locks (2) - Upper & Lower into Lake St. Louis  
1100 - Cruise Lac St. Louis and view the approach to Montreal  
1330 - Arrive at **Lachine, Quebec**  
1400 - Debark for a *Guided Motorcoach Tour* into downtown Montreal  
1500 - Guided tour of the *Montreal Botanical Gardens*  
1700 - Return to the Canadian Empress for dinner  
Evening - Fun loving entertainment and lounge services

- DAY 5 0915 - Depart by bus to visit the *Fur Trade Museum*  
1130 - Depart Lachine bound for Cornwall, Ontario  
Afternoon - Pass through Beauharnois Locks (2) - Upper & Lower  
- Shipboard activities  
Evening - Arrive at **Cornwall, Ontario**  
Evening - Fun loving entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 6 0915 - Transfer to Cornwall's historic *SDG Jail* for guided tour  
1100 - Return to ship for departure to Morrisburg, Ontario  
Afternoon - Transit Eisenhower and Snell Locks (USA)  
1530 - Arrive at **Morrisburg, Ontario**  
1600 - *Step-on Speaker: Maggie Wheeler* is a murder mystery author with an expertise regarding St. Lawrence Seaway history  
- Free time to relax and explore the area around the Morrisburg Municipal Wharf  
Evening - Fun-loving entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 7 0915 - Buses depart for a guided tour at the *Doran Bay Model Ship Museum*  
1130 - Return to the ship for departure bound for Brockville, Ontario  
Afternoon - Pass through Iroquois Seaway Control Lock  
1530 - Disembark at **Prescott, Ontario**  
1545 - Depart by bus for a guided tour of *Fort Wellington National Historic Site*  
1715 - Ship departs Prescott bound for Brockville in the heart of the 1000 Islands  
Evening - Arrive at **Brockville, Ontario** for overnight  
Late Evening - Celebration Night with fun-loving entertainment
- DAY 8 0600 - Depart Brockville  
Morning - Cruise Millionaires' Row on the U.S. Side of the 1000 Islands bound for Gananoque  
1030 - Debark at Gananoque for a guided tour of the *1000 Islands Boat Museum*  
1145 - Depart from Gananoque bound for Kingston, Ontario  
Lunch - Closing Ceremonies  
1330 - Arrival at **Kingston, Ontario**  
1400 - Disembarkation and farewells at Crawford Wharf
