

**ITINERARY - M/V CANADIAN EMPRESS**  
**CONFEDERATION CRUISE**  
**OTTAWA TO KINGSTON (5 nights - 6 days)**

- DAY 1 1630 - Pre-boarding commences at **Hull Municipal Dock**  
1730-1830 - Passenger Boarding  
1800 - Captain's Welcome Reception and Safety Instructions  
1900 - *Harbour Cruise of Canada's Capital* and the waters of the Ottawa River. Sight Canada's Parliament buildings, the Prime Minister's residence, Rideau Falls, and embassies
- Dinner - Empress Class Roast Prime Rib of Beef  
Evening - Return to port in Hull (Ottawa). Enjoy *Canada Day Fireworks* and celebrations on the outer decks with complimentary chocolate and liqueurs
- Evening - Soft music and lounge services
- DAY 2 0700 - Depart Hull bound for Cumberland, Ontario  
0830 - Secure at **Cumberland** dock  
0915 - Coach departs for the *Canadian War Museum*  
1000 - Guided tour of the Canadian War Museum  
1115 - Board coach for return to Canadian Empress  
1200 - Ship departs Cumberland bound for Montebello, Quebec  
Lunch - Comprehensive Safety Presentation  
1430 - Arrive at **Montebello, Quebec**  
1445 - Debark and transfer by bus to *Omega Park Animal Sanctuary* for a guided tour  
1700 - Return to ship for departure to Carillon Lock & Power Dam  
1945 - Arrive at **Carillon Lock Station** for overnight  
Evening - Evening entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 3 0900 - Enter lock for 65 foot drop to the lower level  
0930 - Depart Carillon bound for Ste. Anne de Bellevue  
1145 - Pass through Ste. Anne de Bellevue Lock bound for Lake St. Louis  
Lunch - Sail along south shore of Montreal bound for Lachine  
1330 - Arrive in picturesque **Lachine, Quebec**  
1400 - Debark and transfer by bus to the *Lachine Fur Trade Museum* for a guided tour  
1600 - Afternoon tea in the Grand Saloon  
1800 - Depart by coach to the *Sucrierie de la Montagne* Sugar Shack  
1900 - Dinner and entertainment at the Sugar Shack  
Evening - Return to Canadian Empress for soft music and lounge services
- DAY 4 0730 - Depart Lachine bound for Morrisburg, Ontario  
- Pass through Beauharnois Locks (2) - Lower & Upper  
Morning - Shipboard activities  
1600 - Afternoon tea and Independence Day celebrations  
- Pass through Eisenhower & Snell Locks (U.S.A.) into Lake St. Lawrence  
Evening - Ship arrives at **Crysler Park Marina**  
- Evening entertainment and lounge services

DAY 5 0900 - Depart by horse-drawn wagon to *Upper Canada Village*. After an open-air guided tour, passengers will have free time to discover the Village  
1200 - Transportation returns from the Village  
1230 - Depart Crysler Park Marina bound for Prescott  
1400 - Pass through lock at Seaway Control Dam - Iroquois.  
1430 - Enter and cruise the Old Galop Canal - opened in 1846.  
1545 - Secure at **Prescott, Ontario**  
1600 - Guided tour at *Fort Wellington National Historic Site*  
1715 - Buses return from Fort Wellington.  
1730 - Depart Prescott bound for Brockville, Ontario  
1900 - Arrive at **Brockville** (the city of the 1000 Islands) for overnight  
Evening - Celebration Night and evening entertainment

DAY 6 0600 - Depart Brockville  
Morning - Cruise Millionaires' Row on the U.S. Side of the 1000 Islands bound for Gananoque, Ontario  
1015 - Debark at **Gananoque** for a guided tour of the *1000 Islands Heritage Museum* and *1000 Islands Boat Museum*  
1130 - Depart from Gananoque bound for Kingston, Ontario  
Lunch - Closing Ceremonies  
1330 - Arrival at Kingston, Ontario  
1400 - Disembarkation and farewells at Crawford Wharf
