DAY 3	0915	- Depart by horse-drawn wagon to <i>Upper Canada Village</i> . After an open-air guided tour, passengers will have free time to discover the Village

	Afternoon	- Transit Eisenhower & Snell Locks (USA)
	Evening	- Ship arrives at <b>Coteau Landing, Quebec</b> - Free time to relax and stroll along the old canal system
