2024 ITINERARY – M/V CANADIAN EMPRESS CANADIAN CONNECTION CRUISE - EAST

KINGSTON TO QUEBEC CITY (6 nights – 7 days)

- DAY 1 1715 - Pre-boarding commences on Crawford Dock in **Kingston**
1730-1830 - Passenger boarding
1800 - Captain's Welcome Reception in the Grand Saloon
1900 - Depart Kingston bound for **1000 Islands Anchorage**
Dinner - Empress Class Roast Prime Rib of Beef
After Dinner - Enjoy the beauty of the 1000 Islands on the upper deck with complimentary chocolate and liqueurs
Evening - Stroll around the outer decks under a million stars and among a thousand islands
- DAY 2 0800 - Weigh anchor to wander the 1000 Islands, Wanderer's Channel and the Admiralty Group of Islands bound for Gananoque, ON.
0915 - Debark at Gananoque for a guided tour of the *1000 Islands Heritage Museum*
1100 - Depart Gananoque to cruise the U.S. side of the river.
- View and learn about Boldt Castle on Heart Island.
- View and learn about Singer Castle on Dark Island
Afternoon - Comprehensive Safety Presentation
1515 - Arrive at **Brockville, Ontario**
1530 - Buses depart for guided tour at *Fulford Mansion*
1700 - Return to Canadian Empress for dinner
Evening - Relax and enjoy Brockville's waterfront
Evening - Evening entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 3 0930 - Depart by bus to a guided tour at the *Aquarium*
1115 - Return to ship for departure to Prescott
1400 - Arrival at **Prescott, Ontario**
1430 - Guided tour at *Fort Wellington National Historic Site*
1600 - Depart Prescott bound for Lake St. Lawrence and Chrysler Park Marina
1800 - Ship arrives at **Chrysler Park Marina**
Evening - Relax and stroll the marina and grounds
Evening - Evening entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 4 0915 - Depart by horse-drawn wagon to *Upper Canada Village*. After an open-air guided tour, passengers will have free time to discover the Village.
1200 - Transportation returns from the Village
1230 - Depart Chrysler Park bound for Coteau Landing
- Pass through Eisenhower and Snell Locks (USA)
Afternoon - Canadian Empress arrives at **Coteau Landing, Quebec**
Evening - Free time to relax or stroll along the park and old canal.
Evening - Evening entertainment and lounge services

Over

- DAY 5 0700 - Depart Coteau Landing bound for the Port of Montreal.
- Pass through Beauharnois Locks (2) into Lake St. Louis.
1100 - Witness the continuing approach to Montreal.
- Pass through Cote Ste. Catherine and St. Lambert locks
- Port of Montreal harbour tour (*at Captain's discretion*)
1500 - Arrive at **Old Port of Montreal**
1515 - Board buses to a *Guided Motorcoach Tour of Montreal*
1715 - Return to Canadian Empress
Evening - Free time after dinner to enjoy the unique character of Montreal
- Evening entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 6 0745 - Depart Montreal bound for Trois Rivières, Quebec.
1430 - Disembark at **Trois Rivières** for a brief bus tour en route to visit
the *Shrine at Cap de la Madeleine*
1630 - Return to the Canadian Empress
Evening - Celebration Night with fun-loving entertainment
- DAY 7 0645 - Depart Trois Rivières early morning
Lunch - Closing Ceremonies
1315 - Experience the scenic approach to romantic Quebec City.
- Cruise past *Montmorency Falls* and view the city's easterly approach from
downriver (*at Captain's discretion*)
1400 - Arrive at **Quebec City**
1415 - Disembarkation and farewells - Louise Basin, Quebec City.
