

ITINERARY - M/V CANADIAN EMPRESS
CELEBRATION OF SPRING CRUISE
KINGSTON TO MONTREAL TO KINGSTON (7 nights - 8 days)

- DAY 1 1715 - Pre-boarding commences on Crawford Dock in **Kingston, Ontario**
1730-1830 - Passenger boarding
1800 - Captain's Welcome Reception in the Grand Saloon
1900 - Depart Kingston bound for **1000 Islands Anchorage**
Dinner - Empress Class Roast Prime Rib of Beef
After Dinner - Enjoy the beauty of the 1000 Islands on the upper deck with complimentary chocolate and liqueurs
Evening - Stroll the outer decks under a million stars and among a thousand islands
- DAY 2 0800 - Weigh anchor to wander the 1000 Islands, Wanderer's Channel and Admiralty Group of Islands bound for Gananoque
0915 - Arrive at **Gananoque, Ontario**
0930 - Debark at Gananoque for a guided tour of the *1000 Islands Heritage Museum*
1100 - Depart Gananoque bound for Brockville, Ontario

- DAY 3 0915 - Depart by bus to *Upper Canada Village*. After an open-air guided tour, passengers will have free time to discover the Village
1200 - Transportation returns from Village
1230 - Depart Crysler Park Marina bound for Coteau Landing, Quebec
Afternoon - Transit Eisenhower & Snell Locks (USA)
Evening - Ship arrives at **Coteau Landing, Quebec**
- Free time to relax and stroll along the old canal system
Evening - Fun-loving entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 4 0700 - Depart Coteau Landing bound for the Port of Montreal.
- Pass through Beauharnois Locks (2) into Lake St. Louis.
1100 - Witness the continuing approach to Montreal.
- Pass through Cote Ste. Catherine and St. Lambert locks
- Port of Montreal harbour tour (*at Captain's discretion*)
1500 - Arrive at **Old Port of Montreal**
1515 - Board buses for a *Guided Motorcoach Tour of Montreal*
1715 - Return to Canadian Empress
Evening - Free time after dinner to enjoy the unique character of Montreal
Late Evening- Evening entertainment and lounge services

- DAY 5 0730 - Depart the Old Port of Montreal bound for Cornwall, Ontario
Morning - Shipboard activities
- Transit through St. Lambert and Cote Ste. Catharine Locks
Afternoon - Shipboard activities
- Pass through Beauharnois Locks (2) - Upper & Lower
Evening - Arrive at **Cornwall, Ontario**

- DAY 6 0945 - Transfer to *Saunders Power Dam* for a guided tour
1130 - Return to ship for departure to Morrisburg, Ontario
Afternoon - Transit Eisenhower and Snell Locks (USA)
1600 - Arrive at **Morrisburg, Ontario**
- Free time to relax and explore the area around the Morrisburg Municipal Wharf
Evening - Fun-loving entertainment and lounge services

1130 - Canadian Empress departs Morrisburg bound for Prescott, Ontario
Afternoon - Pass through Iroquois Seaway Control Lock
1530 - Arrive at **Prescott, Ontario**
1545 - Depart by bus for a guided tour of *Fort Wellington National Historic Site*
1730 - Ship departs Prescott bound for Brockville in the heart of the 1000 Islands
Evening - Arrive at **Brockville, Ontario** for overnight
Late Evening - Celebration Night with fun-loving entertainment
- DAY 8 0600 - Depart Brockville
Morning - Cruise Millionaires' Row on the U.S. Side of the 1000 Islands bound for Gananoque
1030 - Debark at Gananoque for a guided tour of the *1000 Islands Boat Museum*
1145 - Depart from Gananoque bound for Kingston, Ontario
Lunch - Closing Ceremonies
1345 - Arrival at **Kingston, Ontario**
1415 - Disembarkation and farewells at Crawford Wharf
