ITINERARY - M/V CANADIAN EMPRESS DISCOVER THE RIVER – May 15-19

KINGSTON to MORRISBURG to KINGSTON (4 nights - 5 days)

- DAY 1 1730 - Boarding commences on Crawford Dock in **Kingston**.
1730-1830 - Passenger boarding
1830 - Captain's Welcome Reception and Safety Instructions in the Grand Saloon
1900 - Depart Kingston bound for **1000 Islands Anchorage**
Dinner - Empress Class Roast Prime Rib of Beef
After Dinner - Enjoy the beauty of the 1000 Islands on the upper deck with complimentary chocolate and liqueurs
Evening - Stroll the outer decks under a million stars and among a thousand islands
- DAY 2 0800 - Weigh anchor to wander the 1000 Islands, Wanderer's Channel and Admiralty Group of Islands bound for Gananoque, ON.
0915 - Arrive at **Gananoque, Ontario**
0930 - Debark at Gananoque for a guided tour of the *1000 Islands Heritage Museum*
1100 - Depart Gananoque to cruise the 1000 Islands

1515 - Arrive at **Brockville, Ontario**

1700 - Return to Canadian Empress for dinner
Evening - Relax and enjoy Brockville's waterfront

- DAY 3 0800 - Depart Brockville bound for Prescott, Ontario.
0930 - Ship arrives at **Prescott, Ontario**.
0945 - Disembark for a guided tour at *Fort Wellington National Historic Site*
1130 - Bus returns from Fort Wellington.
1200 - Depart Prescott bound for the St. Lawrence Seaway
- Cruise along the old Galop Canal - opened in 1846
Afternoon - Pass through the Iroquois Lock at the Seaway control dam
- Cruise east on Lake St. Lawrence bound for Morrisburg, Ontario
1500 - Arrive at **Crysler Park Marina** to pick up speaker before departing for Lake St. Lawrence
1530 - *Lost Villages Presentation: Maggie Wheeler* is a murder mystery author with an expertise regarding St. Lawrence Seaway history
1730 - Return to **Morrisburg** for overnight
Evening - Evening entertainment and lounge services

1130 - Depart Morrisburg bound for the 1000 Islands
Afternoon - Ship board activities

1700 - Arrive at **Gananoque, Ontario**
Evening - Celebration Night and evening entertainment
- DAY 5 0730 - Depart Gananoque for a relaxing breakfast cruise through the 1000 Islands
0915 - Return to Gananoque
0930 - Debarck for a guided tour of the *1000 Islands Boat Museum*
1045 - Return to Canadian Empress
1100 - Depart Gananoque and sail through the Canadian channel en route to Kingston
Lunch - Closing ceremonies during lunch sittings
1330 - Harbour Tour of Kingston
1400 - Arrive at Crawford Dock in Kingston
1415 - Disembarkation and farewells - Brock St. Dock, Kingston.
