KINGSTON to CRYSLER PARK to KINGSTON (4 nights - 5 days)

- DAY 1 1730 - Boarding commences on Crawford Dock in **Kingston**.
1730-1830 - Passenger boarding
1830 - Captain's Welcome Reception and Safety Instructions in the Grand Saloon
1900 - Depart Kingston bound for **1000 Islands Anchorage**
Dinner - Empress Class Roast Prime Rib of Beef
After Dinner - Enjoy the beauty of the 1000 Islands on the upper deck with complimentary chocolate and liqueurs
Evening - Stroll the outer decks under a million stars and among a thousand islands
