ITINERARY - M/V CANADIAN EMPRESS CANADA'S CAPITAL CRUISE- SOUTH

OTTAWA TO KINGSTON (5 nights - 6 days)

- DAY 1 1730 - Boarding commences at **Hull Municipal Dock**
1730-1830 - Passenger Boarding
1830 - Captain's Welcome Reception and Safety Instructions in the Grand Saloon
1900 - *Harbour Cruise of Canada's Capital* and the waters of the Ottawa River. View Canada's Parliament buildings, the Prime Minister's residence, Rideau Falls, and embassies
- Dinner - Empress Class Roast Prime Rib of Beef
Evening - Return to port in Hull (Ottawa). Enjoy Canada's Capital on the outer decks with complimentary chocolate and liqueurs
Evening - Soft music and lounge services
- DAY 2 0700 - Depart Hull bound for Cumberland, Ontario
0830 - Secure at **Cumberland** dock
0915 - Coach departs for the *Canadian Aviation and Space Museum*
1000 - Tour of the Aviation and Space Museum
1115 - Board bus to return to Canadian Empress
1200 - Ship departs Cumberland bound for Montebello, Quebec
Lunch - Comprehensive Safety Presentation
1445 - Arrive at **Montebello, Quebec**
1500 - Debark and transfer by bus to *Omega Park Animal Sanctuary* for a guided tour
1700 - Return to ship for departure to Carillon Lock & Power Dam
1945 - Arrive at **Carillon Lock** for overnight
Evening - Evening entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 3 0900 - Enter Carillon Lock for 65 foot drop to the lower level of the Ottawa River
1000 - Depart Carillon bound for Ste-Anne-de-Bellevue
1200 - Pass through Ste-Anne-de-Bellevue Lock into Lake St. Louis and the St. Lawrence River
1400 - Arrive at **Lachine, Quebec** for overnight
1415 - Debark and transfer by bus to the *Lachine Fur Trade Museum* for a guided tour
1630 - Return to Canadian Empress. Free time before dinner to enjoy the unique character of Parc St. Louis in Lachine
Evening - Evening entertainment and lounge services
- DAY 4 0700 - Depart Lachine bound for Chrysler Park Marina
Morning - Pass through Beauharnois Locks (2) - Lower & Upper
- Shipboard activities
Afternoon - Pass through Eisenhower & Snell Locks (U.S.A.) into Lake St. Lawrence
1530 - Afternoon tea
Evening - Ship arrives at **Chrysler Park Marina**
- Evening entertainment and lounge services

Over

- DAY 5 0915 - Depart by horse-drawn wagon to *Upper Canada Village*. After an open-air guided tour, passengers will have free time to discover the Village
- 1200 - Transportation returns from the Village
- 1215 - Depart Crysler Park Marina bound for Prescott
- 1315 - Pass through lock at Seaway Control Dam - Iroquois.
- 1400 - Enter and cruise the Old Galop Canal - opened in 1846.
- 1445 - Secure at **Prescott, Ontario**
- 1500 - Debark to board buses to guided tour at *Fort Wellington National Historic Site*
- 1630 - Buses return from Fort Wellington.
- 1645 - Depart Prescott bound for Rockport, Ontario
- 2000 - Arrive at **Rockport** for overnight
- Evening - Celebration Night and evening entertainment
- DAY 6 0730 - Depart Rockport bound for Gananoque
- Morning - Cruise Millionaires' Row on the U.S. Side of the 1000 Islands bound for Gananoque, Ontario
- 1015 - Debark at **Gananoque** for a guided tour of the *1000 Islands Heritage Museum* and *1000 Islands Boat Museum*
- 1145 - Depart from Gananoque bound for Kingston, Ontario
- Lunch - Closing Ceremonies
- 1330 - Kingston Harbour Tour
- 1400 - Arrival at **Kingston**
- 1415 - Disembarkation and farewells at Crawford Wharf
